What do I need to do?

For information to those of you who are new since last year, we divide Hayling Island into 54 separate groups of roads, and the cards within those groups are sorted into roads ready for delivery. This means that in most cases you will be able to cover the area on foot if you so wish. The number of cards per group varies, but the largest and longest routes can normally be covered in less than 2 hours.

When do I collect my cards?

Cards, already sorted into groups and roads, can be collected from the HQ between 9:00 and 11:30am on the delivery day. Although ideally these should be delivered on the Sunday, this is not necessary if you are already committed. All I ask is that the cards are delivered by 24th December. The earlier they can be delivered the better it looks for us and the easier it is to resolve any anomalies that we come across.

Why not pre-book your roads?

Once again you can pre-book roads, either online (preferred) at our website www.hayling Scouts.org.uk and selecting either the “stamp” or “letter box”, by completing the form within the Scout HQ reception area or by calling me on 9246 2786. However, it is always good to have some people available on the day who are happy to cover any unallocated roads.

How can I buy stamps?
